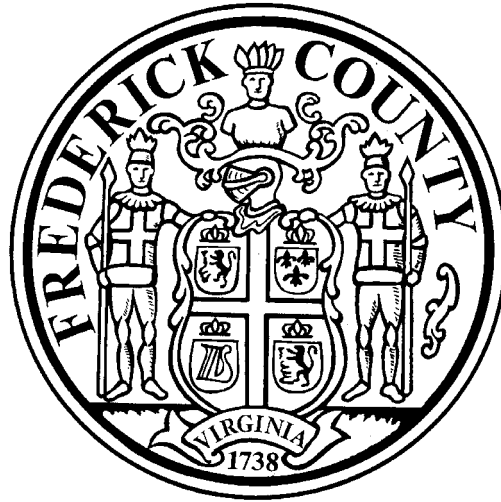

INSTRUCTIONS - SEPTIC HAULERS PERMIT

FREDERICK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

On February 24, 2010 the Frederick County Board of Supervisors approved revisions to Chapter 161 (Sewage Disposal Systems) of the County Code. This ordinance revision contains a requirement that all persons engaged in the business of transporting sewage, cleaning septic tanks, settling tanks and/or vaults in Frederick County must obtain a Septic Haulers Permit from Frederick County. The Septic Haulers Permit fee is \$200.00.

In order to apply for a Septic Haulers Permit you must bring a copy of your Commonwealth of Virginia Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) Operators Permit, your Loud Fairfax Health District Septic Haulers Number and your Winchester- Frederick County Service Authority Haulers Number.

A Septic Haulers Permit is permanent and does not need to be renewed. A copy of this permit must be kept in each vehicle operated by the business.

*Please note that Chapter 161 also requires that all vehicles utilized to haul sewage within Frederick County be inspected annually by the Virginia Department of Health in Frederick County. Inspections conducted in localities other than Frederick County will not be honored.

I understand that a copy of the Septic Haulers Permit must be carried in the glove compartment of each business vehicle operated.

I understand that all business vehicles utilized to haul waste must be annually inspected by the Virginia Department of Health – Lord Fairfax Health District.
