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SENIOR CITIZEN AND DISABLED PERSONS Deferral of Payment of Real Estate Taxes

- Any Senior Citizen or Disabled Person who is eligible for a partial Real Estate tax exemption (e.g., 10%, 35% or 60%), based on total combined income of more than \$20,000 but not greater than \$50,000, may request deferral or delay of payment of the remainder (non-exempt portion) of the RE tax due.
- An Application for Deferral of Payment of RE Taxes must be filed annually by April 1 with the Commissioner of the Revenue.
- You do not have to defer/delay payment of all your RE taxes owed but can pay part of it and defer/delay payment of part of it. The total accumulated amount of deferred/delayed RE taxes must be paid to the County when the dwelling is sold or from the decedent's estate within one year after the death of the last owner who qualifies for the tax deferral.
- The deferred/delayed amount of RE taxes will accrue interest at 8% per annum, but no penalty.
- Changes to income, financial worth, property ownership or other factors during the filing taxable year may affect qualification for exemption and deferral.

SENIOR CITIZEN AND DISABLED PERSONS APPLICATION FOR DEFERRAL OF PAYMENT OF REAL ESTATE TAXES

Pursuant to § 115-20.1 of the Frederick County Code, any person eligible for a partial Real Estate tax exemption (e.g., 10%, 35% or 60%) may request deferral (or delay) of payment of the remaining portion of the Real Estate tax due. The total of all Real Estate tax amounts that are deferred (or delayed) for payment become a debt against the property which must be paid to the County when the dwelling is sold or from the decedent's estate within one year after the death of the last owner who qualifies for the tax deferral.
