 - A single story with a roof eave height not exceeding 10'
 - Accessory to an existing or future dwelling
 - Used for a tool or storage shed, play house or similar use

Buildings exceeding 256 square feet, more than one story, or used for other purposes require a building permit. An electric permit (if applicable) is required regardless of the size of the building.

Prior to constructing the building, an inquiry of the zoning ordinance for the setbacks to Planning and Development shall be required.
