9. Committee Business - Finance Committee

- 9.A. Finance Committee Business
 - (*) Items 1, 2, 5, and 9 were approved on the Committee consent agenda.
- 1. () The Deputy County Administrator requests a General Fund supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$51,281. This amount represents a carry forward of unspent FY20 funds for carpet installation that is currently in process. Approved on Committee Consent Agenda.
- 2. (**1**) The F&R Chief requests a General Fund supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$76,000. This amount represents a carry forward of unspent grant funds for the Stephens City Swiftwater Team. The grant and appropriation were originally approved by the BOS on 11/13/19. Approved on Committee Consent Agenda.
- 3. The P&R Director requests a General Fund supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$55,000. This amount represents proffer funds for an outdoor gym facility at Clearbrook Park. The P&R Commission approved the request on August 11, 2020. The committee recommends approval.
- 4. The Public Works Director requests a General Fund supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$20,000. This amount represents funds donated and reserved for the spaying and neutering of shelter pets. The Public Works Committee approved the request on July 28, 2020. No local funds required. The committee recommends approval.
- 5. (**1**) The Public Works Director requests a General Fund supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$2,495. This amount represents unspent FY20 grant funds for environmental education. The grant appropriation was originally approved by the BOS on 10/23/19. The Public Works Committee approved the request on July 28, 2020. Approved on Committee Consent Agenda.
- The Public Works Director requests a Landfill Fund supplemental appropriation not to exceed \$1,327,298. This amount represents a carry forward of unspent FY20 funds for various projects. The Public Works Committee approved the request on July 28, 2020. The committee recommends approval.
- 7. The Sheriff requests General Fund supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$11,492.03. This amount represents 2 auto insurance claims and will go toward auto repair and the purchase of a new vehicle. No local funds required. The committee recommends approval.
