Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Recycling Program Important Reopening Guide Please read BEFORE coming to the landfill to dispose of items.

The Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program will reopen on Wednesday, August 19 from 12pm-6pm and the Electronics Recycling Program will reopen on Wednesday, August 26 from 7am-11am.

HHW/Electronics program usage rules:

The following rules will be in effect at Household Hazardous Waste and Electronics program until further notice:

- All individuals must remain in their vehicle at all times.
- All individuals in the vehicle must wear a face mask. Mask will not be provided.
 NO MASK. NO SERVICE!
- ALL material for drop off must be in the rear-most portion of the vehicle (pickup bed; trailer; trunk; or hatchback) and may NOT be in the passenger compartment of the vehicle. Items will not be collected from the passenger compartment. If the customer has a van, or hatchback, the material must be removable through the rear doors. ALL items need to have easy access for employees to unload them in a safe manner.
- Customers with large or console/wooden floor model TVs must bring them by pickup truck, trailer or rear access van.
- This program is for Frederick County, Clarke County and the City of Winchester residents only.
- eCycle Disposal is limited to four (4) electronic items per vehicle.
- Normal eCycle charges apply & all other program conditions are also in effect.
- Expect a line and delays.

Visit <u>www.fcrecycles.net</u> to confirm the type of items accepted, the quantity limits and preparation of items that may be brought to this program. Remember, electronics other than screen may be dropped off anytime during normal convenience center hours.

Until further notice, both of these programs will be held ONLY once per month (HHW – 3rd Wednesday from 12pm-6pm; eCycle – 4th Wednesday from 7am-11am).
