Draft Update of the 2021-2022 Frederick County Primary and Interstate Road Improvement Plans – The Primary and Interstate Road Improvement Plans establish priorities for improvements to the Primary and Interstate road networks within Frederick County. Comments from the Transportation Committee will be forwarded to the Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors. Ultimately, the priorities adopted by the Board of Supervisors will be forwarded to the Commonwealth Transportation Board for consideration.

The Virginia Department of Transportation and the Planning Commission of Frederick County, in accordance with Section 33.2-331 of the Code of Virginia, will conduct a joint public hearing in the Board Room of the Frederick County Government Center, 107 North Kent Street, Winchester, Virginia at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 5, 2021. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comment on the proposed Six Year Plan for Secondary Roads for Fiscal Year 2022. Copies of the proposed Plan and Budget may be reviewed at the Edinburg Office of the Virginia Department of Transportation, located at 14031 Old Valley Pike, Edinburg, Virginia or at the Frederick County offices located at 107 North Kent Street, Winchester, Virginia. All projects in the Secondary Road Improvement Plan that are eligible for federal funds will be included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which documents how Virginia will obligate federal transportation funds.
