Final Minutes Frederick County Electoral Board Wednesday, July 14, 2021

The Frederick County Electoral Board met on Wednesday, July 14, 2021. Those presents were Chairman Marie Straub, Vice-Chairman Craig Lambert, Secretary Tom Reed, Registrar Rich Venskoske and Deputy Registrar Diane Lockhart.

- 1) The meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm by Chairman Straub.
- 2) On motion from Secretary Reed and seconded by Vice-Chairman Lambert, the agenda was approved as printed.
- 3) On motion from Secretary Reed and seconded by Vice-Chairman Lambert, the minutes from the May 12, 2021, monthly meeting and June 11, 2021, Canvass were approved as printed.
- 4) New Business:
 - (a) June Primary
 - 1. The turnout, as expected, was very low with a turnout of only 4.5% of voters.
 - 2. The expenses associated was just over fifteen dollars per vote.
 - 3. No major issues or problems were experienced, other than a reminder to confirm polling place access on election day.
 - 4. Canvass was without issue with limited absentee ballots received.
 - 5. New poll books program worked well and provided insight to operation for November election.
 - (b) As required by the state, a Split Precinct Waiver was unanimously approved by the Board of Supervisors and will be submitted to the state for their final approval.
 - (c) The Frederick County Voting System Security Plan was reviewed and approved by the Electoral Board.
 - (d) The Electoral Board Budget for 2021/2022 was reviewed as approved by the Board of Supervisors.

(e) A Special Election is to be held in Stephens City to fill two seats on the Town Council this Fall.

5) Other Business

- (a) Early voting begins September 17, 2021, L&A is scheduled for September 14, 2021, with three EPB laptops and three DS200s. Two DS200s at Sunnyside and one for the Registrar's office.
- (b) The Electoral Board approved special consideration for providing one DS200 to each precinct rather than two as an alternative suggested by the state due to expected turnout.
- (c) Work will continue with DemTech on poll books to review available options for later implantation.

6) Registrar Business

- (a)) The Registrar's budget was approved as submitted to the Board of Supervisors.
- (b) State Registrar annual training program is scheduled for late August and early September.
- (c) The number of ballots for the November General and Special Election was discussed, with numbers to be determined at August meeting.
- 7) The next meeting is scheduled for 4:30 pm, August 11, 2021, at Registrar's office.
