INSTRUCTIONS

A pump and haul system is defined as "any device or system in which a sewage holding tank is pumped out on a regular basis and the raw sewage is transported by motor vehicle by a contractor having a valid sewage handling permit to an authorized treatment plant. The term "pump and haul" includes all facilities and appurtenances necessary to collect and store the sewage for handling by a contractor having a valid sewage handling permit".

In order to qualify for a permanent pump and haul the following criteria must be met:

- 1. The structure to be served is one of the following:
 - a. An existing dwelling that has no indoor plumbing and is converting to indoor plumbing, or where an existing onsite sewage system has failed;
 - b. An existing structure used as a place of worship;
 - c. An existing school structure;
 - d. An existing commercial structure; and
- 2. The Health Department has rejected an application for an onsite sewage system otherwise permitted under this chapter, or an off-site system;
- 3. All other options for a sewage system (i.e. off-site easement, boundary line adjustment) have been pursued and found unsatisfactory as evidenced by a denial letter issued by the Health Department and/or documentation that securing an easement or boundary line adjustment with a neighboring property owner is not possible (via sale or gift); and
- 4. There shall be no additional bedrooms or bathrooms added to the dwelling or structure as a result of the permitting of a permanent pump and haul system.

In accordance with Chapter 161 of the Code of Frederick County if a property does qualify to apply for a permanent pump and haul sewage disposal system it must be reviewed by and if appropriate, it may approved by the Frederick County Board of Supervisors. *Please note that approval of a permanent pump and haul system is not guaranteed.* If the system is approved and installed, the property owner is required to maintain a maintenance contract with a Hauler that is licensed in Frederick County. This Hauler is contracted by the property to provide necessary pump outs of the system as well as to ensure that the system is functioning properly. It should be noted that a pump and haul system can be costly to maintain due to the necessity of multiple monthly pump outs. The property owner or any perspective buyer of the property should contact a licensed Hauler to determine the potential monthly cost of the system. The property owner is also required to provide annual invoices verifying pump to the Virginia Department of Health (VDH) and the system must be inspected by the VDH every three years. There is a cost for the mandatory inspection that must be paid by the property owner.

enter into this Contract with the County of Frederick, Virginia (the "County"), on this day of, 20
WHEREAS, in consideration of the County's approval of a pump and haul permit for the property located at, PIN#, and to provide for sewage collection and disposal services for a pump and haul system and guarantee compliance with all applicable regulations concerning sewage collection and disposal services.
THE PARTIES AGREE as follows:
The Property Owner will maintain a contract with the specified Septic Hauler and will ensure that the system is being property pumped and that 24-hour call service is maintained for emergency service.
The Property Owner will submit annual invoices to the Virginia Department of Health verifying that the system is being property pumped.
The Property Owner will procure an inspection from the Virginia Department of Health every three years (from the date of permit issuance) to ensure that the system is in proper working order.
The Property Owner grants permission for employees of the County and the Virginia Department of Health to conduct routine field inspections of the system to ensure proper maintenance.
The Property Owner understands that violation of the conditions of the pump and haul permit or violation of any applicable regulations concerning sewage collection and disposal services may lead to the revocation of the pump and haul permit.
The Septic Hauler agrees to provide sewage pump and hauling services to the Property Owner at a cost of per load and the Property Owner agrees to pay for such services according to such normal and commercially reasonable terms as the Septic Hauler may provide.
