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☐ 747 Full-Time Students enrolled in basicREC Offered an 8<sup>th</sup> Camp basicREC location for the summer of 2023 serving 350 students across all locations Provided 1,495 swim lessons Almost 200 swim team participants Over 100 Adult Sports League teams ■ 58% Increase in the Thanksgiving 5K with 1,173 runners □ New Scavenger Hunt Fun Runs were introduced averaging 78 runner per event ☐ Youth Basketball has over 1000 children playing on 96 teams with an additional 200 participating in the Cheer program Offered 4 medium sized events: Youth Trout Derby, Someone Special Sweetheart Dance, KiteFest, and Sportfest which brought over 1600 visitors to the parks Senior Trip participants have doubled over the past year and most of the 2024 trips have already sold out ☐ July 4<sup>th</sup> welcomed over 9,500 visitors to Sherando Park for a concert, fireworks, and a variety of vendors ☐ Walking in a Winter Wonderland welcomed 39,337 visitors to Clearbrook Park for our signature winter event


